

## 'Gêm Kim'

### Y Gêm Fictoraidd sy'n Herio'r Cof!

Yn Ionawr 1901, bu farw'r Frenhines Fictoria, gan ddod â'r hyn a elwir yn Gyfnod Fictoria i ben ym Mhrydain. Ar yr un adeg, roedd llyfr newydd Rydyard Kipling, sef 'Kim' yn cael ei gyhoeddi yn wythnosol mewn papur newydd. Yn y llyfr, mae 'Kim', arwr y llyfr, yn defnyddio gêm gof fel rhan o'i hyfforddiant i ddyfod yn ysbïwr. Daeth y gêm hon i gael ei hadnabod fel 'Gêm Kim' ac yn aml byddai oedolion a phlant yn ei chwarae ar droad y ganrif yn y 1900au.

#### Rheolau:

1. Trowch y bwrdd o gwmpas a threulio 30 eiliad i edrych ar y lluniau o'r gwrthrychau.
2. Ar ôl 30 eiliad, trowch y bwrdd o gwmpas fel nad ydych chi'n gallu gweld y lluniau ddim mwy.
3. Ar ddarn o bapur defnyddiwch bensil i ysgrifennu gymaint o wrthrychau ag y gallwch eu cofio. \*Gallwch ofyn i rywun arall eu nodi wrth i chi weiddi enwau'r gwrthrychau yn eu tro.
4. Ar ôl nodi pob gwrthrych rydych yn ei gofio, trowch y bwrdd o gwmpas eto a chyfrwch faint rydych wedi eu cael yn gywir.
5. Ceir cyfanswm o 20 gwrthrych. Faint wnaethoch chi eu cofio? Gwnewch gystadleuaeth ohoni i weld beth yw sgor eich teulu a'ch ffrindiau!

## 'Kim's Game'

### The Ultimate Victorian Memory Game!

In January 1901, Queen Victoria died, ending what was known as the Victorian Era in Britain. At that time Rydyard Kipling's new book 'Kim' was being published weekly in a newspaper. In the book 'Kim', the book's hero, uses a memory game as part of his training to become a spy. This memory game became known as 'Kim's Game' and was often played by adults and children in the early 1900's.

#### Rules:

1. Turn the board around and take 30 seconds to look at the pictures of objects.
2. After 30 seconds turn to board back around so you can no longer see the pictures.
3. Pick up the note pad and pencil and write down as many objects as you can remember. \*You can always get someone to write them down while you shout them out if you like.
4. Once you have written down all the objects you remember, turn the board back around and count how many you had right.
5. There are 20 objects in total. See how many you can remember and make a competition out of it by seeing what score your family and friends can get!
